



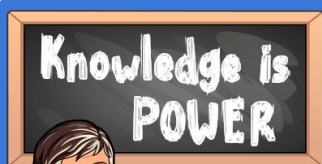

Staying healthy

As we unite to recover from the effects of COVID-19, it's still important that we maintain our new hygiene measures, including washing our hands, hand sanitising and coughing or sneezing into our elbow.



In Alert Level 2 we developed some new procedures that we have found incredibly beneficial for our tamariki. Our noticings...

- An increased confidence of our tamariki to walk into school all by themselves
- Tamariki have greater responsibility for their own belongings
- A calmness and smooth, uninterrupted transition of entering the classroom each morning
- Increased security with the gates closed during the day of our tamariki and their possessions, including bikes and scooters.
- Teachers are seeing and able to talk with whānau at the end of each day

Due to this we have decided to keep the procedures as identified below

● Deanwell School opening hours are 8.30am - 3.00pm

NO STUDENTS ARE TO ARRIVE EARLIER THAN 8.30am

- Only three gates will be open in Alert Level 1...
 - Hall gate
 - Staff car park gate
 - Back gate near the swimming pool
- The gates will be open in the...
 - Morning: - 8.30 - 9.00am
 - Afternoon: - 2.45 - 3.15pm
- If you require entry into school outside the gate opening hours you will need to come through the front office



PICK UP AFTER SCHOOL REMAINS THE SAME

- Kōkako and Tūi OHU, and their siblings from other OHU, will be at the front of the school at 3.00pm ready for pick up
- Pīpī Manu, Kārearea and Kererū will be out the front of the school by 3.05pm ready for pick up
