Due to the high growth population projections as a result of the Peacocke development, the Ministry of Education is currently exploring options to ensure students in the designated areas have the highest quality learning available, with an easy commute.

The Ministry of Education are proposing the addition of a new Primary school in the development **BUT NOT** a new school for Years 7 - 13. Instead they are proposing a reorganisation of our existing schools, Melville Intermediate and Melville High School on their current site.

This is an opportunity to re-think and establish what future education looks like for our tamariki and the future generations to come. There four options...

<u>OPTION</u>	<u>The Four Proposed Reorganisation Options</u>
<b>1</b>	<b><u>ONE SCHOOL</u></b> Re-organisation of Year 7-13 Education in Melville Merging the two schools into a Year 7 – 13 school (one school).
<b>2</b>	<b><u>TWO SCHOOLS</u></b> Re-organisation of Year 7-13 Education in Melville Redeveloping the two schools into a Junior High School (Year 7-10) and Senior High School (Year 11-13).
<b>3</b>	<b><u>TWO SCHOOLS</u></b> The same structure that we currently have. An Intermediate and a High School Both schools stay as they are (Year 7-8 and Year 9-13)
<b>4</b>	Another option generated from the consultation process

With each of the **OPTIONS** above we also need to consider how we want each **OPTION** to be **GOVERNED**. Do you want to ...

1. Retain two Board of Trustees **OR**
2. Establish a Combined Board of Trustees?

**These OPTIONS will also have implications for Principalship. Will we have one **OR** two Principals?**
