The meeting will be held at the Glenview Club on Monday 22 May at 6pm.

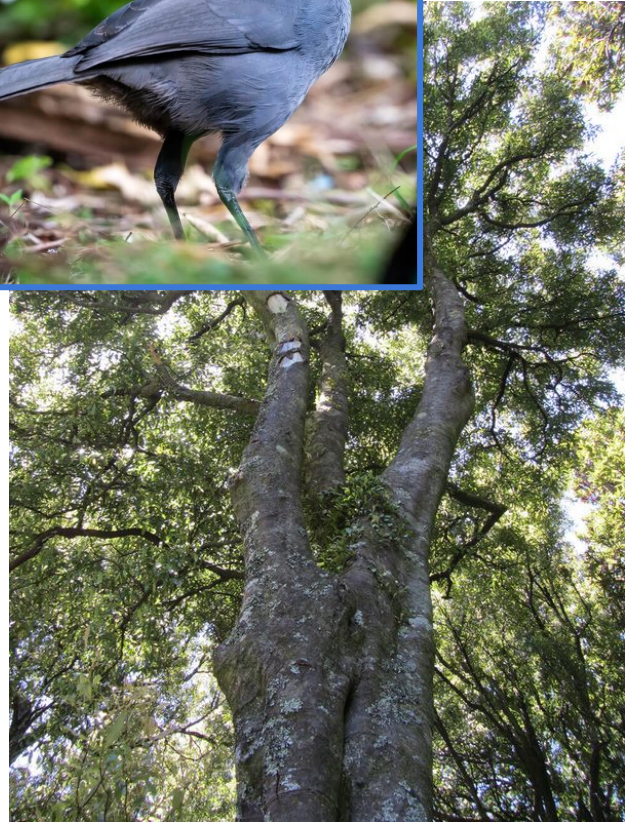
