# Deanwell Enrolment Scheme

Deanwell School has had an enrolment scheme since April, 2007.

An enrolment scheme is implemented to avoid overcrowding, or the likelihood of overcrowding.

The Ministry in consultation with the Board have decided to remove the four classroom block, near the community playground currently occupied by Pīpī Manu Waru and used for cooking and music. The Ministry is paying to have it removed as they/we do not have sufficient finances to renovate it. We are hoping that this will be done during the Christmas holidays.


Hence, the removal of these four classroom spaces means we have had to amend our maximum enrolment numbers. Our maximum roll was 450 and our **MAXIMUM ROLL IS NOW 400** 

Under this scheme, students will be enrolled if they live within the home zone described below.

#### Home Zone Descriptions

Commencing at the railway line on Collins Road, follow the line north to Kahikatea Drive. Turn right into Kahikatea Drive (includes South side only) through to Kahikatea Road/Ohaupo Road intersection. Turn right onto Collins road (West side only) following that road through to Dixon Road/Ohaupo Road intersection.

Turn left onto Dixon Road. Follow Dixon Road to the end (turn right). Draw a straight line across to Hall Road. Follow Hall road to the Ohaupo Road intersection. Draw a line from the Hall Road/Ohaupo Road intersection to the Collins Road/O'regan Road intersection. Follow O'Regan Road to the O'reagan Road/Collins Road intersection. Follow Collins Road east to the railway line.



# Deanwell Enrolment Scheme continued...

#### Out of Zone Enrolments

Each year the Board will determine the number of places which are likely to be available in the following year for the enrolment of students who live outside the home zone.

The Deanwell School website will indicate how applications are to be made and will specify a date by which all applications must be received.

Applications for enrolment will be processed in the following order of priority

- Priority 1 Siblings of current students
- Priority 2 Siblings of former students
- Priority 3 Children of Board Employees
- Priority 4 Children of Board members
- Priority 5 Attendance at Deanwell Kindergarten, Deanwell Playcentre, Bright Stars, Active Explorers, Glenview Kindergarten, Little Preschoolers
- Priority 6 All other applicants

If there are more applicants in the first, second, third, fourth or fifth priority groups than there are places available, selection within the priority group will be by ballot conducted in accordance with instructions issued by the secretary under Education and Training Act 2020.

Parents will be informed 5 days after the ballot date of their application status.

## Whānau can you please help us?

Our roll today is 390 students so we are only 10 students off being at capacity.

- 1. Can all whānau please fill in an expression of interest for tamariki that will be coming to Deanwell that are not currently enrolled.
- 2. If you know of whānau in our community who have tamariki that will be coming to Deanwell can you please ask them to come into the office and fill out an expression of interest.

## Please know that all tamariki inside our zone will be accepted.

(Whānau will need to provide proof of address)

#### **Enrolment Process**

All students in zone or out of zone must fill in an expression of interest.

You can complete the expression of interest on the Deanwell School website OR by coming into the office and filling out a paper copy.
