PRE-ORDER STATIONERY FOR 2024


\$40 - full year (\$10 for each of the four terms)

Dear Whānau.

This year, 2023, we trialled purchasing all the stationery required for all students for the full year. Whānau paid for the stationery at the office or set up online payments. This has been highly successful.

Teachers select stationery that suits each student's learning. For example, research tells us that explicitly teaching handwriting helps students develop legible writing that can be produced quickly with little conscious attention. We use a number of different books with varying lines, pens and pencils with and without pencil grips according to a students handwriting capability. Students will be given the stationery they need to learn best. This varies for each student.

Stationery can be ordered through the school office. These can be prepaid and ordered now so your child will receive their stationery ready to begin the school year.

In these challenging financial times, if anyone is in a position to donate money to support other whānau to pay their stationery we would all be very grateful.


