Each January all Deanwell's employees come together for a 2 night, 3 day noho marae. This is an opportunity to learn and work together to ensure we are fully connected with the land, sea and each other.

It is a time where we reflect on our 'Te Whare Tapa Whā' to ensure we are the best we can be for our Deanwell tamariki and their whānau. You are all worthy of aroha and belonging without judgement.

As tumuaki of Deanwell I am incredibly proud of all our employees. Every year they attend noho marae with great enthusiasm, energy and eagerness to learn. Then the week after noho they spend collaboratively planning and preparing for Term 1 ensuring they are fully organised for our tamariki.

As a community and board we are so fortunate to have such committed employees.





Noho Marae ki Te Papatapu 22nd - 24th Hanuere 2025

A significant aspect of noho marae is the preparation of kai, fostering a deep connection to food by sourcing as much as possible locally and eating what is in season. It is an opportunity to prepare and enjoy meals that are unprocessed, homemade, and not store-bought or takeaway. The process of working together—preparing, sharing, eating, and tidying up—reinforces the importance of collective effort and learning. We also honor the practice of karakia, expressing gratitude and blessing the food.

One evening, we enjoyed mutton sourced from a local farmer, slow-cooked on a spit borrowed from the local club, served alongside an array of roasted vegetables and salads.

The following night, we shared a feast of freshly caught fish from the moana. Our meal featured kahawai in coconut cream, kingfish with soy sauce and wasabi, gurnard lightly pan-fried with the skin on, and snapper battered and deep-fried. These dishes were complemented by a variety of fresh salads.

A special thank you to Rereata Rupapere who taught how to harvest harakeke and raranga.


