



# Health Update

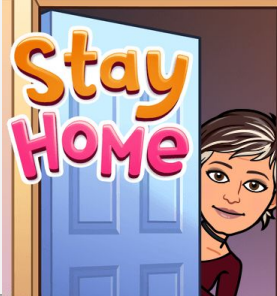


**We are currently experiencing a wave of illness affecting many of our students, staff, and whānau. Recovery is taking some people two to three weeks.**

# Road Safety #5

If you want to park your car please park your car somewhere away from the congestion. Our tamariki can walk into school even when it is raining.



**Before School:** All people to assemble on grass areas or near gates .

**DO NOT GATHER ON THE FOOTPATH.**

**After School:** All tamariki who walk home are to do so immediately.

Tamariki waiting for whānau are to sit down on the seat in front of concrete garden.

If wet tamariki stand under cover of office/walkway or inside office.
