Involve the teaching of two languages te reo Māori and English.

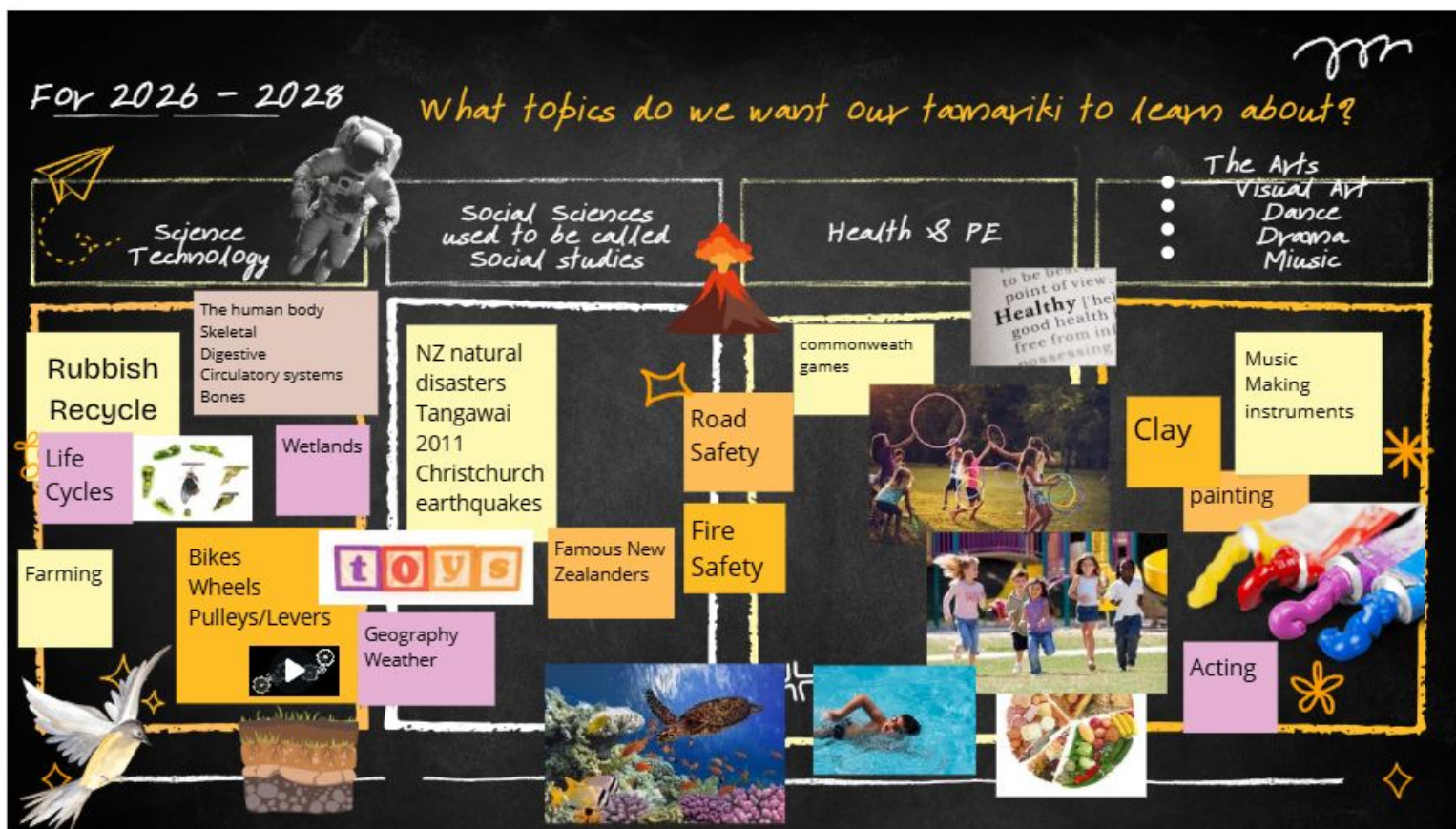
