- We hope to announce our cast list

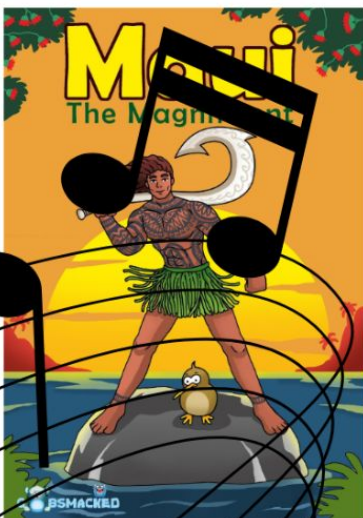
